Order

WHEREAS, Vidyasagar Primary Teachers' Training Institute, Vill – Dhamail, Po-Amdan, PS-Panskura, Dist-Purba Medinipur, West Bengal – 721131 [Code No.APE0647] had applied for grant of recognition for P.T.T. (D.Ed.) Course of two years duration under Section 14 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the ERC, NCTE on 18.04.2006.

2. AND WHEREAS upon consideration of the written representation submitted by the institution as well as documents and materials submitted by the institution, visiting team report along with application the Eastern Regional Committee in its 87<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 23<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup> July 2008, came to the conclusion that recognition to the said institution be refused for the following reasons:

- i. Fresh affidavit of Rs. 100/- stamp paper showing Built- up area 1000 Sq. mt. not submitted.
- ii. Principal & 5 teachers are not qualified as per NCTE norms.
- iii. The list is not countersigned by competent authority of affiliating body.
- iv. Building completion certificate submitted but not duly signed by the competent authority.

3. AND WHEREAS the institution preferred an Appeal to the Appellate Authority, NCTE-HQrs and the Appellate Authority vide order No.F.No.89-334/2008-Appeal/ 92613 dated 20.03.2009 had remanded back the case to ERC-NCTE for causing inspection of the institution.

4. And whereas as per the directions of the Appellate Authority, the Letter of Intent prior to recognition under 7(9) of regulations issued to the institution on 18.04.2009.

5. AND WHEREAS upon consideration of the written representation submitted by the institution as well as documents and materials submitted by the institution along with application the Eastern Regional Committee in its 99<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2009, came to the conclusion that recognition to the said institution be refused for the following reasons:



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- (i) No reply in response to ERC notice dated 18.07.2009
- (ii) List of teaching staff not submitted by the institution in prescribed format. The institution is required to submit details of appointment requisite no. of teaching staff as per the NCTE norms and submit the required affidavits as per the prescribed format.
- (iii) The downloaded copies of the website covering, inter alia, the details of the institution, its location, name of the course applied for with intake, availability of physical infrastructure (land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities/amenities), instructional facilities (laboratory, library etc.) and the particulars of their proposed teaching and non-teaching staff etc. with photographs not submitted.

6. AND WHEREAS the institution preferred an Appeal to the Appellate Authority, NCTE-HQrs against the said order of ERC and the Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-1010/2009-Appeal/A6117 dated 06.11.2009 had reversed the ERC's order dated 31-07-2009 with direction to ERC to grant 3 month time to the institution for appointing the qualified staff as per norms and thereafter process the file as per Rules.

7. AND WHEREAS upon consideration of the written representation submitted by the institution as well as documents and materials submitted by the institution along with application the Eastern Regional Committee in its 106<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>th</sup> April, 2010, came to the conclusion that recognition to the said institution be refused for the following reasons:

- (i) The institution has submitted the same experience certificate submitted earlier. The Experience certificate of the Principal is not as per NCTE Norms.

8. AND WHEREAS the institution preferred an Appeal to the Appellate Authority, NCTE-HQrs against the said order of ERC and the Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-688/2010-Appeal/A25548 dated 24.09.2010 had reversed the ERC's order dated 30-04-2010 with direction to ERC to issue orders under clause 7(11) of the NCTE Regulations within 15 days.

9. NOW, THEREFORE, as per the order of the Appellate Authority vide No. 89-688/2010-Appeal/A25548 dated 24.09.2010 and in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Vidyasagar Primary Teachers' Training Institute, Vill – Dhamait, Po-Amdan, PS-Panskura, Dist-Purba Medinipur, West Bengal – 721 131**, for conducting **P.T.T. (D.Ed) Course of two years** duration with an annual intake of **50 students** from the academic session **2010-2011** under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) existing Regulation subject to fulfilment of the following:

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- (i) The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cutoff date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012 only.
- (ii) Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 200 teaching days the session is fulfilled as per the calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.
- (iii) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Eastern Regional Committee.
- (iv) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (v) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
- (vi) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

10. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

12. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

13. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

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14. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal to National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi-110002 against this order under section 16 of the NCTE Act, 1973 within 60 days of the issue of this order. The guidelines of appeal are enclosed herewith.
